## What are the income guidelines?

## What Rules Apply?

- You must be a patient of a Community Clinical Services physician. They are affiliated with St. Mary's Regional Medical Center.
- You must apply.
- You must re-apply every 90 days. \*If you could be eligible to enroll in Medicaid, you must apply and show a copy of the denial if applicable.
- You must provide proof of income.
- Sliding-fee discounts apply to deductible, coinsurance and co-pay amounts if you have or Medicare.
- Patients are approved by number of people in the family or household, and based on family or household income.
- You receive an eligibility card listing the names of those qualified and level of discount.
- To receive your discount, your enrollment card must be presented at the time of each visit.
- You are expected to pay your share of the discounted fee at the time of service. If you are unable to do so, we ask that you make arrangements with our billing service CBO at 777-4111 to make regular payments until the balance is paid.

## Who are we helping?

No matter what your age or what your family situation, if you are income-eligible for FQHC, we can help.

*Here are some ways that we help:*

### **Do you have health insurance through an employer but have high deductibles? Perhaps your insurance doesn't cover doctor's office visits?**

If you are income-eligible, we can assist by applying our sliding-fee scale to your office deductibles.

### **Do you have Medicare coverage?**

We can assist income-eligible Medicare patients who do not have companion plans by applying our sliding-fee scale to your co-insurance amounts. Due to our FQHC status there are no deductibles for Medicare patients in our practices.

### **Are you without health insurance?**

We can assist individuals who are income-eligible by applying our sliding-fee scale.

## Does the discount apply to services at St. Mary's Regional Medical Center?

The sliding-fee discount applies primarily to services provided by the FQHC in a physician's practice. It also applies to some specific services at the hospital. When seeking hospital services, please present your FQHC card at the point of service registration. The hospital Business Office will then take care of your bill as necessary, and may be in touch with patients who need to apply for the hospital's Charity Care Program.

It is important to remember that while the FQHC discount is a sliding-fee, St. Mary's charity care is free.

### **What else do I need to know?**

- This is not an insurance program.
- There are no premiums to pay.
- Your only cost is your part of the service fee after the sliding-fee discount has been applied.
- You have to keep your eligibility current by submitting the needed forms every 90 days.

## **Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC) provide primary and preventive health services to qualified individuals and their families.**

We are like any other doctor's office but we offer these differences:

- A sliding-fee scale designed to make our care more affordable to patients who are income eligible.
- Expanded office hours to make our care more accessible for busy individuals and families.
- Intergrated mental health program.
- Transportation assistance.
- Access to social services needed by patients and their families.
- Preventive health care and education to encourage patients to prevent illness before it happens.
- Interpreter and cultural broker service.
